

Informational Text Annotations for Answering Questions

1st Read - Understand Unknown Words

- Read quietly
- Mark with dot unknown words
- Underline parts of word

2nd - Understand Main Idea/Gist

- Number the paragraphs
- Circle key words in the paragraphs
 - Who/what is it about?
 - What about it? Did what?
- Write Gist on the margin of your paper

Understanding the Question

- Read question
- Circle any unknown words.
- Box in the signal word (5W's & H).
 - Who** - people or animals
 - What** - details
 - Where** - place
 - When** - time
 - Why** - reasons
 - How** - Process/steps
- Highlight the important words. (What words will appear in the text?)

Answering the Question

- Read and highlight the text to gather evidence for your response.
- Restate the question - Use part of your question in your response.
- Answer the question fully, in your own words, with evidence, examples, details, reasons, and transition words.

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
