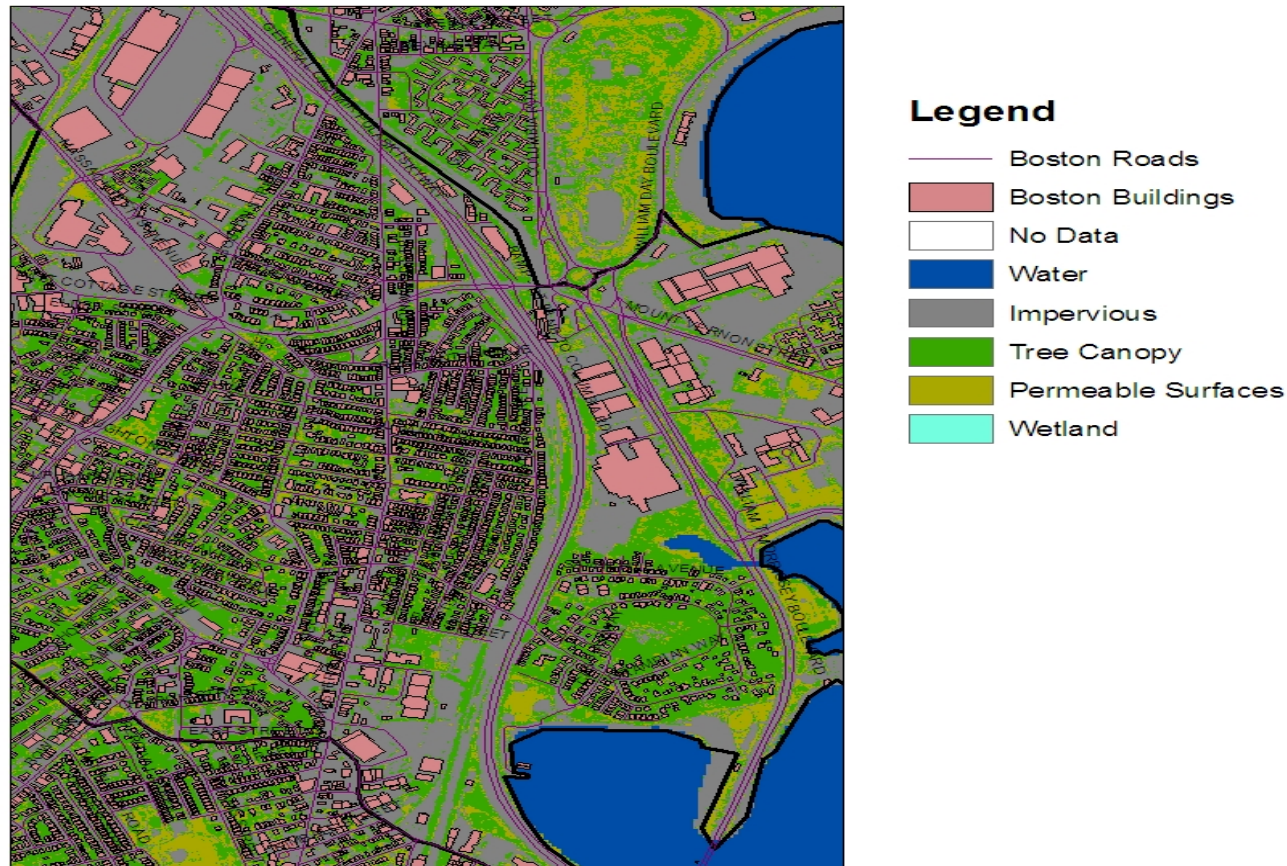

Land Cover Use in Boston - 2007



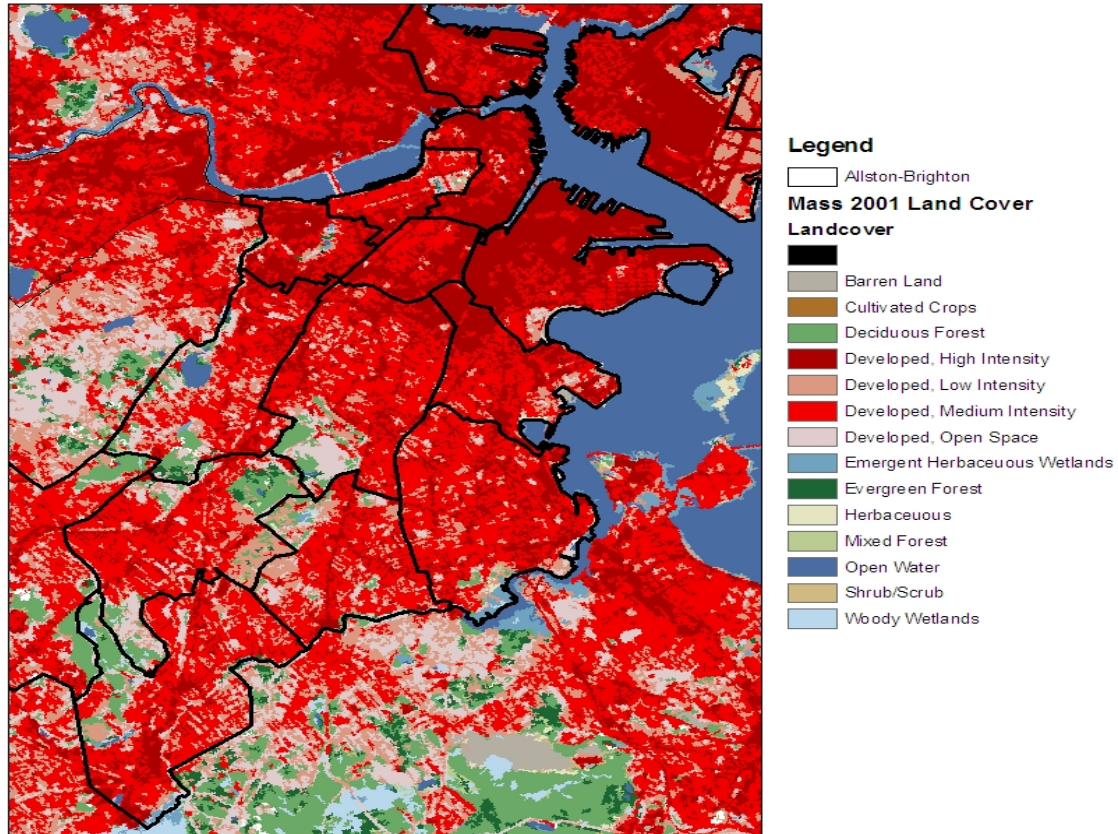

What does Land Use look like in Boston

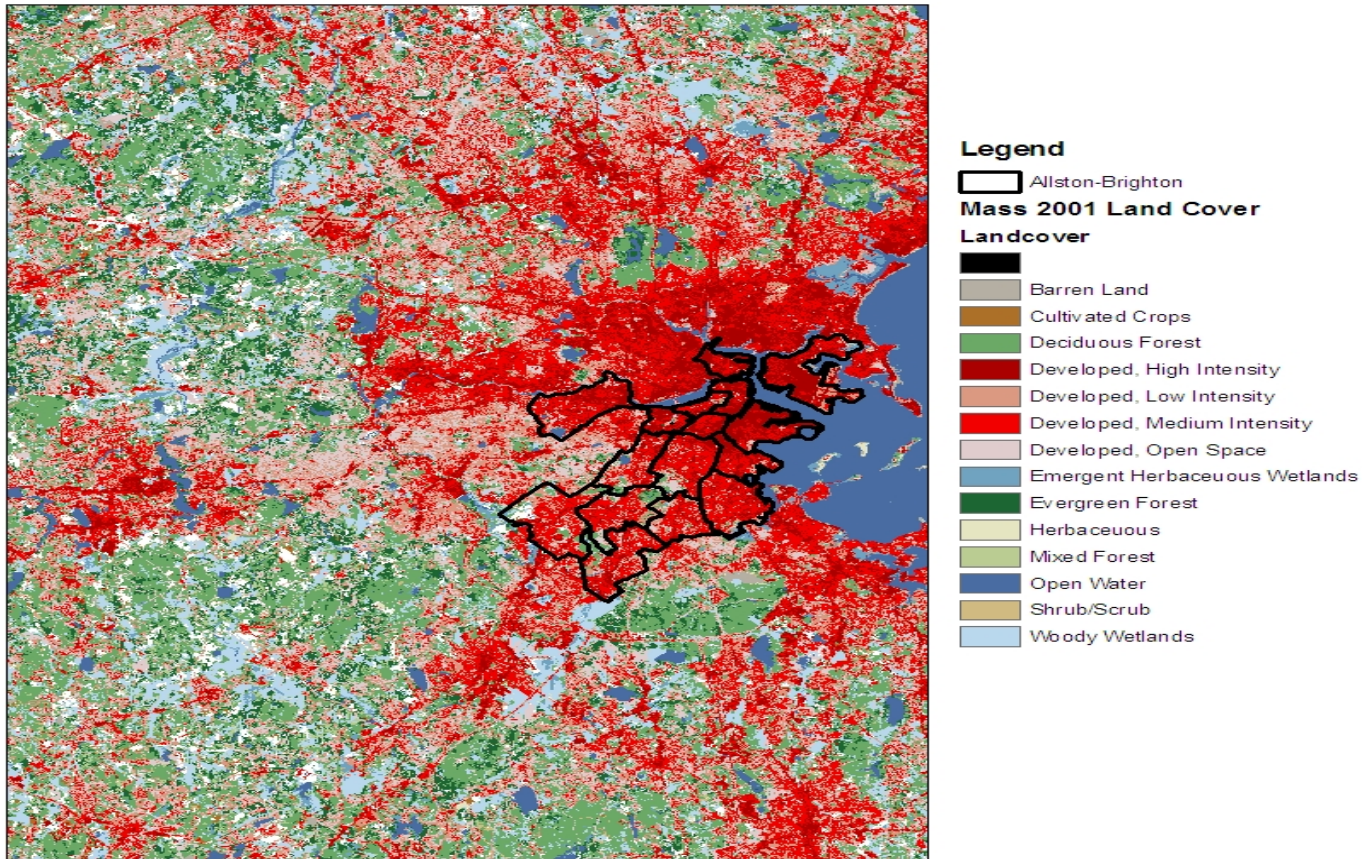


1 inch equals 1.42 miles

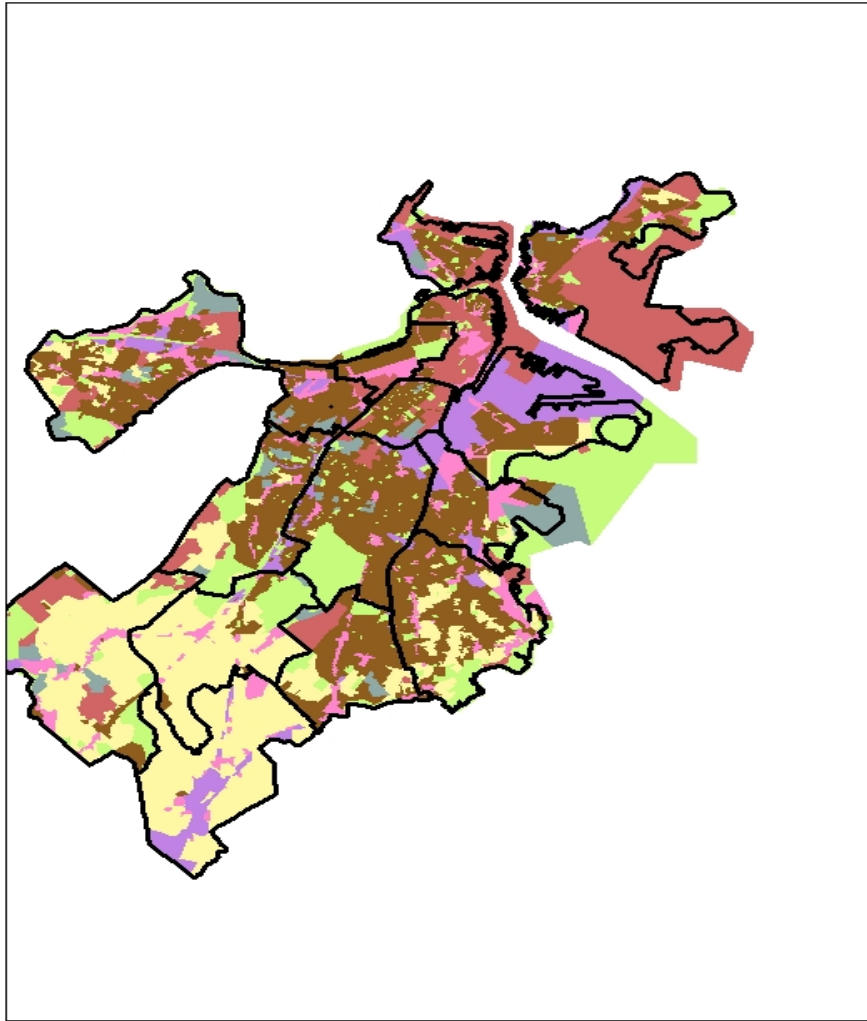


Boston Land Use: 25 mile radius
