
Watersheds





A Watershed describes an area of land where all water entering the system exits at a specific point

Watersheds

- Generally:
 - Water flows from high land to low land
 - Water exists at a specific point in the system, usually through a river or other water body
 - Watersheds can be considered on large or small scales
 - Impervious surfaces can increase the overland flow of water, decrease infiltration into the ground water, upsetting the natural balance of the watershed
