[2] Honors students must demonstrate proficiency in a second language. This requirement is met through the completion of 2102 language courses at LMU, AP credits toward language courses as determined by the registrar, or by placement examination. International students fulfill this requirement by TOEFL proficiency in English as a Second Language.

[3] Honors Thesis *may* be fulfilled through a thesis/capstone project developed through a capstone course in the major. A capstone course in the major will not satisfy the thesis requirement unless it culminates in a thesis or project. Students fulfilling the thesis requirement through a course in the major must obtain prior approval from the Honors Assistant Director.
